PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

2019 Salary Contract, Fringe Contract Break New Ground, Provide Significant Pay Hikes

I want to thank our Bargaining Teams and CAPE staff for their outstanding efforts during this extended 2019 salary and fringe contract bargaining season. The overwhelming support the agreements received in our ratification vote on September 25th showed CAPE members appreciate the hard work our teams put into securing what I would consider fair pay raises over the three-year terms.

Along with the overall pay raises and the long lists of bonuses members will receive, we also

secured a first-ever CAPE Delegate Pilot Program. County management finally conceded that it was in everyone's interest to have our Association's backbone -- the CAPE Delegates -- on paid release time to help coordinate union activities and communications. Under the new program, CAPE delegates can be released -- with pay -- from their normal job duties to help union activities for up to 10 hours through the contract term. That might not seem like a lot of time, but with our delegates skills and engaged efforts, the work we can do will make a huge difference.

There are several other provisions of the new contract that will facilitate our efforts to communicate with CAPE members, especially new members. Under the terms of the agreement, the County is required to provide CAPE leaders with contact information for new employees within 30 days of hire. That means we can finally make contact with all of the new hires in CAPE's six county units. This information, along with new requirements that provide us with enough notice and meeting time to properly coordinate our New Employee Orientations.

All of these pay hikes and allowances are on top of the long list of gains won in our most recent Fringe Contract Negotiations. Our team, coordinated with the other 9 county unions under the umbrella of the County Coalition of Unions, won significant increases in the County's contribution to the Choices program; a total six percent increase over the next three years.

Next, the Fringe Contract provides a \$500 one-time pay bonus and 8 hours of additional time to be credited within 60 days of contract approval. And then, all CAPE members will receive a "Sustainability Bonus" of 1% and a 2.75%, in 2020 and 2021, respectively. There are requirements to receive the full 3.75% pay hike, but virtually all members will receive it in the first year, and all CAPE members will receive the full amount in the second year.

There are more provisions, including caps on cash-in-lieu take home pay for CAPE members waiving Choices coverage. I'd encourage everyone to look up the full list for their bargaining unit at www.CAPEunion.org.

County Board of Supervisors Votes Unanimously to Ratify Salary Contract Agreements for CAPE Members

94% of CAPE Members Voted YES in September to Ratify Pay Raise Agreement

Following the overwhelming approval of the Salary Contract Agreements by CAPE members in all six county units in late September, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors voted unanimously on October 15, to ratify salary contract agreements.

The three-year salary contract agreement includes an overall 7% pay increase, as well as bonuses and special pay practices for many CAPE-represented job categories. The package also included a first ever CAPE Delegate Pilot Program that will facilitate member organizing and internal communications for the next contract negotiations cycle.

The pay package includes three pay raises: 2% retroactive to January or March, depending on the Unit; 2.5% on October 1, 2019, for all Units; and 2.5% on October 1, 2020, for all Units.

Additionally, qualifying members in all six CAPE units will receive additional pay as a result of bonuses from licensing, registration and certifications as detailed in the ratification materials.

A Benefit Of Being A CAPE Member: CAPE Representing You In Your Promotional Exam Appeal

As a Member CAPE offers you an important member benefit, representation if you decide to challenge the results of a promotional exam.

If you challenge the results of a promotional exam and file a Protest with the County's Department of Human Relations, the Department's Appeals Section will notify you and your Department to schedule a meeting to discuss the merits of your Protest.

CAPE Business Agents have many years of experience representing our members in such meetings. Upon your request, a Business Agent will prepare with you for the meeting and provide you representation in your meeting with your Department.

If your Protest is denied by the Department of Human Resources or it does not answer your Protest within 60 days of filing it and you decide to file a Petition for Hearing with the County's Civil Service Commission, CAPE may represent you in those proceedings. Upon your request, CAPE will provide you an attorney to review the Petition for Hearing you have filed with the Commission to determine if an amended Petition with additional information or allegations should be filed. CAPE's attorney will also prepare you for the Commission's meeting on your Petition and provide you representation before the Commission and in any additional Civil Service proceedings.

This is a valuable Member benefit CAPE offers to its members. CAPE provides this benefit in recognition of the importance our members place on opportunities to advance their careers.

CAPE Surveyor Members to Receive Long Overdue Inequity Bonus

After years of fighting to receive an inequity bonus the Surveyors were successful in receiving a 5% pay hike. CAPE members in the Survey Series made an inequity presentation during the CAPE Unit 511/512 negotiations and outlined a compelling argument detailing their retention and recruitment problems. The Survey Series has been dealing with substantial loss in staff because they are going to other agencies for higher pay and an aging workforce with several retirements. Many of these positions have not been filled once vacant. This challenge has made it impossible for surveyors to keep up with the workload, and due to the glaring retention problem, they won the inequity bonus. Congratulations LA County Public Works surveyors!
